Unique Situation: Clients With Children

The Situation:

You cook for a family with four children ranging in ages from one month, seventeen months, three years, and four years old. You charge \$350 for the standard service for two adults. The four year old doesn't eat anything, and the seventeen month old and three year old eat everything!

The Question:

How do you plan your menu to accommodate the family?

In some instances you may not have every bit of information – which may affect your decision. If in doubt, plan for a worst-case scenario. Always consider that resources may not be available, time is working against you and that you need to find an answer that benefits all involved plus keeps the client happy. Sometimes there are more than one correct answer or approach.
